I can't believe it was four years ago this month that my Mom adopted me! My previous family put me up for adoption.

As with most rescue dogs, I had some behavior issues to overcome, but with training, patience, time and treats (my favorite!), I have come a long way! You can't change a rescue dog's past, but you can rewrite his future. Rescue does not mean damaged. It means they have been let down by humans. On behalf of my fellow rescue dogs and cats, please make adoption your only option! Layers of love are revealed on both ends of the leash. You can't buy love, but you can rescue it!

Sadly, like many young couples, their Fur Baby is their baby until they have a baby...then their once-beloved family pet becomes neglected. I was also abused and I had some fear behavior issues as a result. My adoption ad read, "Will be euthanized if not adopted soon....Time running out..".

During that same time, my Mom was finally ready to adopt a dog after losing Heidi, who had been by her side for 17 years. My Mom wasn't looking for a specific breed, only to adopt a dog that otherwise might not be adopted.
